A. Does the patient have any difficulty, even with glasses, recognizing faces, watching TV, reading, cooking, playing sport?

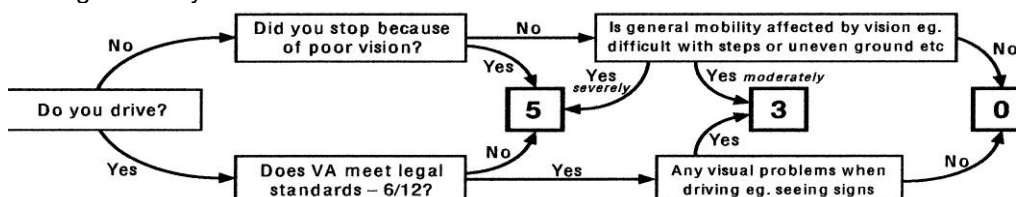
