Dealing with suspected child abuse in patients examined within Community Optometric Practice

Following an excellent presentation at the Three Counties Optometric Society meeting in September 2010 by **Dr Imelda Bennett** (Consultant Paediatrician, Designated Doctor for Safeguarding Children, Gloucestershire Safeguarding Children Board), it was felt that the following information would be of benefit should the situation ever arise that you in the course of an examination become suspicious that a child might be being subjected to abuse. Clearly these issues are very sensitive and need to be managed with great care. It is recommended that you take advice before any action is initiated and to document all observations, decisions and actions.
