
Improved security

- Clinician access is specific to a particular screening result
- Clinician codes are only created by printing a referral letter or asking for a code
- Clinician codes expire after 6 months, but a new code can be requested easily.


3 levels of access

- Clinicians can self-register, but then the must have a Referral code to view anything
- Clinicians can also be attached to one particular organisation, in which case they can search the database without a referral code but they need the child's name and date of birth
- Clinician Administrators will have one or more schools added to their profile and they can browse and see all the children in those schools who failed their vision check or were force referred. They have no access to children who passed their vision check or had no check carried out yet. They can also request a Referral code and export list of children.


Clinician Access page



Registering as a clinician




Clinician browse screen




Different levels of referral
